PACKATHON SET FOR OCTOBER 11TH & 12TH 2011

The ISIS Foundation's annual Packathon is tentatively set for October 11th and 12th 2011. The Courtyard Hall, in Bothell Washington, will be the gathering place of our volunteer team who will sort and inventory a huge stack of medical supplies donated by ten area hospitals. Theses supplies will then be packaged and shipped in a 20 foot container to their destination at Kiwoko Hospital in Uganda.

The supplies and equipment assembled at the 2010 Packathon are on their way to Kiwoko. A status update from the shippers indicates that the arrival date in Mombasa will be July 19th 2011. From there, the 20' container will make a trip to Kampala, Uganda, then an overland journey to Kiwoko Hospital. IDEAS FOR STORAGE SPACE

With a move to a new office space, the ISIS team is considering relocating the storage space where donations are collected throughout the year. Our current space is located in Bothell at 9000 NE Bothell Way.
